

LOW CHART OF COURSE EXPECTATIONS



- **PRE-REQUISITES:** At least 1 year experience as OT before attending the course.
- **AIM:** 1. To make participants conversant in theory and research related to Ayres Sensory Integration ®
 - 2. Discuss relationship of sensory integration to neurobiological principles and occupation.
- **EQUIPMENT NEEDED:** No equipment. Literature as described in reading list.
- **ASSESSMENT FOLLOWING COURSE:** Complete self study post course questionnaire online within the same year, and within the set time frame provided.



- **PRE-REQUISITES:** Attendance of a Theory Course
 - Buy course package for course
- **AIM:** 1. To provide in-depth knowledge of the process of evaluating sensory integration and praxis through the use of the Sensory integration and Praxis Test (SIPT) and Ayres clinical observations.
- **EQUIPMENT: COMPULSORY:** SIPT course package & SIPT Manual
 - SIPT test kit.
- **ASSESSMENT FOLLOWING COURSE:** To be submitted before specified date to SAISI office
 - Peer review (proof in writing)
 - SIPT reports: submit 4 typically developing children & 1 child with suspected SI difficulties
 - **NOT FOR SUBMISSION AFTER this course BUT TO BRING ALONG TO Test Interpretation Course:** (Ayres & GM clinical observations, sensory questionnaires, other tests done etc for child with suspected SI difficulties)



- **PRE-REQUISITES:**
 - Completion of post Theory Course self study questionnaire.
 - Submission of **Peer review, 4 Typically developing children and 1 child with suspected SI difficulties to SAISI office**
- **AIM:** 1. The interpretation of the SIPT scores, structured and unstructured clinical observations and patterns of dysfunction.
- **EQUIPMENT: Bring case of child with suspected SI difficulties including SIPT & SIPT report, clinical observations, sensory questionnaires and any other information. 5 min DVD of child during assessment**
- **ASSEMETN FOLLOWING COURSE:**
 - SIPT administration scoring pass (by mentor) proof sent with protocol
 - At least 1 Mentoring session - proof sent with protocol submission
 - Protocol according to set guidelines on child with suspected SI patterns of dysfunction.



- **PRE-REQUISITES:**
 - **Submission AND Pass** of protocol before specified date
 - **If a participant needs to REDO parts/whole of the protocol the participant will not be able to attend treatment within that year.**
- **AIM:** 1. To reach intervention strategies within the Ayres Sensory integration frame of reference.
 - 2. **To promote clinical reasoning and case based problem solving**
- **EQUIPMENT: Bring case of child with suspected SI difficulties including SIPT & SIPT report, clinical observations, sensory questionnaires and any other information. 5 min DVD of child during treatment.**
- **ASSESSMENT FOLLOWING COURSE:**
 - Submission of a case study with a treatment DVD for assessment on Fidelity Measure within 6 months following the course. Need to obtain a score of 80% for Fidelity Measure process elements to pass.
